BLOCK PARTY!

It is time to get the community together! The RM of Stanley Council wants to encourage community building by assisting with neighborhood block parties!

HOW IT WORKS:

The host will contact the RM Office and provide some basic information as to location, date, etc and they will also be provided a host package with a variety of gifts and ideas to assist them with the event.

The host package will include a variety of helpful items like:

- Printed invitations to invite the neighborhood.
- Authorization for hot dogs, buns, drinks and ice cream
- A few ice breaker block party game ideas.
- An outdoor game kit (Bocce ball, Kubb set, Spike ball set)
- A few other gifts.

Why should I host a block party?

- Meet your neighbours!
- Knowing who lives in your neighbourhood helps build connections with others.
- Increases our physical and mental wellness.
- Neighbours who know each other, look out for each other.
- To help establish a sense of belonging in the community.
- Provide opportunity to exchange skills or resources (babysitting, book club, walking kids to school, home or vehicle repair, personal networking, etc.)
- To have fun! No excuses or reasons needed to celebrate community!

THINGS TO CONSIDER

- Try to keep group sizes manageable, maybe around 60 people or less, smaller groups encourages more interaction and opportunity to build connections - it's also easier for you to organize the event with fewer people.
- Avoid on street parking to ensure emergency access. Contact our Public Works Dept if you want to use a public right-of-way or public space.
- Alcohol consumption is not permitted on rights-of-ways or public property.
- Consider if pets will or won't be allowed and inform your neighbours.
- Plan a few icebreaker games - the RM quiz and bingo will be included!
- Keep fires to a reasonable size, fires and fireworks are subject to burn bans.
- Clean up afterwards and don't forget to arrange next year's host!

Who do I invite?

- No set of rules or requirements.
- Try to be inclusive to all your neighbourhood or street.
- Some villages are small enough the whole village could be invited while larger ones will need to be broken down by areas.
- For rural folks, their "block" may extend a few miles in each direction.

What do I need to do as host?

- Talk to a few neighbours and pick a date.
- Determine location and details including who to invite.
- Contact the RM Office and submit your block party host form.
- Hosts will receive the block party kit.
