BY-ELECTION

There will be a by-election to fill the vacant Ward 1 seat on Council. Nominations will be received at the RM Office January 30, 31, February 1, 4, & 5. To be eligible a candidate will need to meet the following criteria:

- * Must be a Canadian citizen at least 18 years of age on election day; and
- * Must be a resident of the municipality at least 6 months prior to election day, OR a registered owner of land in the municipality at least 6 months prior to election day

Election day is March 12th. Further information as to who has filed nomination papers and where voting will take place should be available in the news media after the close of nominations.
