JULY 2012

2012 Taxes will be due on Tuesday, October 30th, 2012.

Payment options: cash, cheque, debit (in person) or on-line through your banking institution. Credit cards are NOT accepted. There is an after hours drop-off box at our administration office for your convenience. Be sure to include your roll number(s) or the bottom portion of your tax statement(s) to ensure proper accounts are credited.

For on-line payments allow 5 business days for processing.

An interest penalty of 0.83% per month will be applied to all overdue accounts not received in the administration office before the due date.

If you have sold a property in the Municipality in the past year and have received the tax statement in error, please forward it to the new owner. Please contact your lawyer to confirm which party is responsible for payment of the 2012 taxes as we do not receive this information. A copy of the tax statement is sent to the owner on file as of the mailing date.

Manitoba Farmland School Tax Rebate

There is a rebate that property owners may apply for through MASC. Landowners who have a Farmland Assessment are eligible for a 80% rebate through the program. *This rebate applies to school taxes paid on farm land only.* Forms are available online through our website. An annual application must be sent in to your nearest MASC Insurance office with proof of taxes paid.

If you have received a 2011 rebate a pre-printed application will be sent to you with the previous year's listing included along with an estimated amount.

Manitoba Education Property Tax Credit Advance Program

If you are a Manitoba resident and property owner of a single dwelling unit as of January 1st you may qualify for this credit on your tax statement. You must pay more than \$250 of property tax and the dwelling must be your primary residence. If you do not receive the credit application forms can be filled out at the admin office. Please call for further details and information required by the Province to process the request.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

You may have noticed crews trimming trees in the Villages along the sidewalks. This is done for pedestrian safety, to extend the life of the pavement, and also to make snow clearing easier in the winter. If planting new trees near sidewalks please keep this in mind and give reasonable room for the trees to grow.

Our construction and maintenance crews are out in full force again this summer. They are maintaining roads, replacing culverts and bridges, fixing ditches, and much more. Please take extra precaution when approaching and passing construction and maintenance equipment and crews.

The RM has spent considerable time and money on proper signage for the RM. If signs are missing or abused, do not hesitate to call the office with details. Just a reminder that private signs on public sign posts are not allowed, as they detract from the original intent of the sign. It is also a criminal act to remove any signage from public roadways, as it can cause serious accidents.
