	TITLE: Civic Addressing	Department: Public Works

This policy supersedes any prior policy dealing with the same matters.

POLICY STATEMENT:

To establish guidelines and standards for the provision and installation of civic addressing signs in The Municipality.

PROCEDURES:

The RM of Stanley will use *The Civic Addressing Standard for Manitoba* as the guidelines for assigning & installing civic addresses to properties.

Generally, The Municipality will supply and install civic addresses at locations/driveways where public utilities are present (i.e. hydro, gas, phone, water.)

Although there will be times when the civic addresses need to be located on private property, civic addresses will be installed, whenever possible, on public Right of Ways.

Address posts will be installed in locations which are visible and cause as little disturbance/disruption to the landowner as is reasonably practical.

Broken, Damaged, Missing civic address signs will be replaced by The Municipality with records of replacements to be kept.

Landowners are to notify the municipality of civic address signs that need to be repaired/replaced.

In cases of repeated negligence or intentional disregard, The CAO may at their own discretion charge for the replacement costs of the sign.

The civic address posts and signs are and remain at all times the property of the RM of Stanley.
