

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF STANLEY

BY-LAW NO. 2-06

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-Law 3-98 which established a ward system for the purpose of electing Municipal Councillors.


AND WHEREAS under Section 88 of The Municipal Act, Council deems it necessary to amend the number of wards and ward boundaries for the purpose of achieving representation by population;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Rural Municipality of Stanley enacts as follows:

1. THAT the number of wards set out in Clause 1 under By-Law 3-98 be changed from five wards to two wards, as per attached Schedule "A";
2. THAT the named five wards set out in Clause 2 under By-Law 3-98 be changed as follows:
 - 1) Ward One - **(East Ward) Four to be Elected**
 - 2) Ward Two - **(West Ward) Two to be Elected**
3. THAT this By-Law takes effect at the next general election.

DONE AND PASSED as a By-Law of The Rural Municipality of Stanley at Morden, in the Province of Manitoba, this 9th day of March, A.D. 2006.

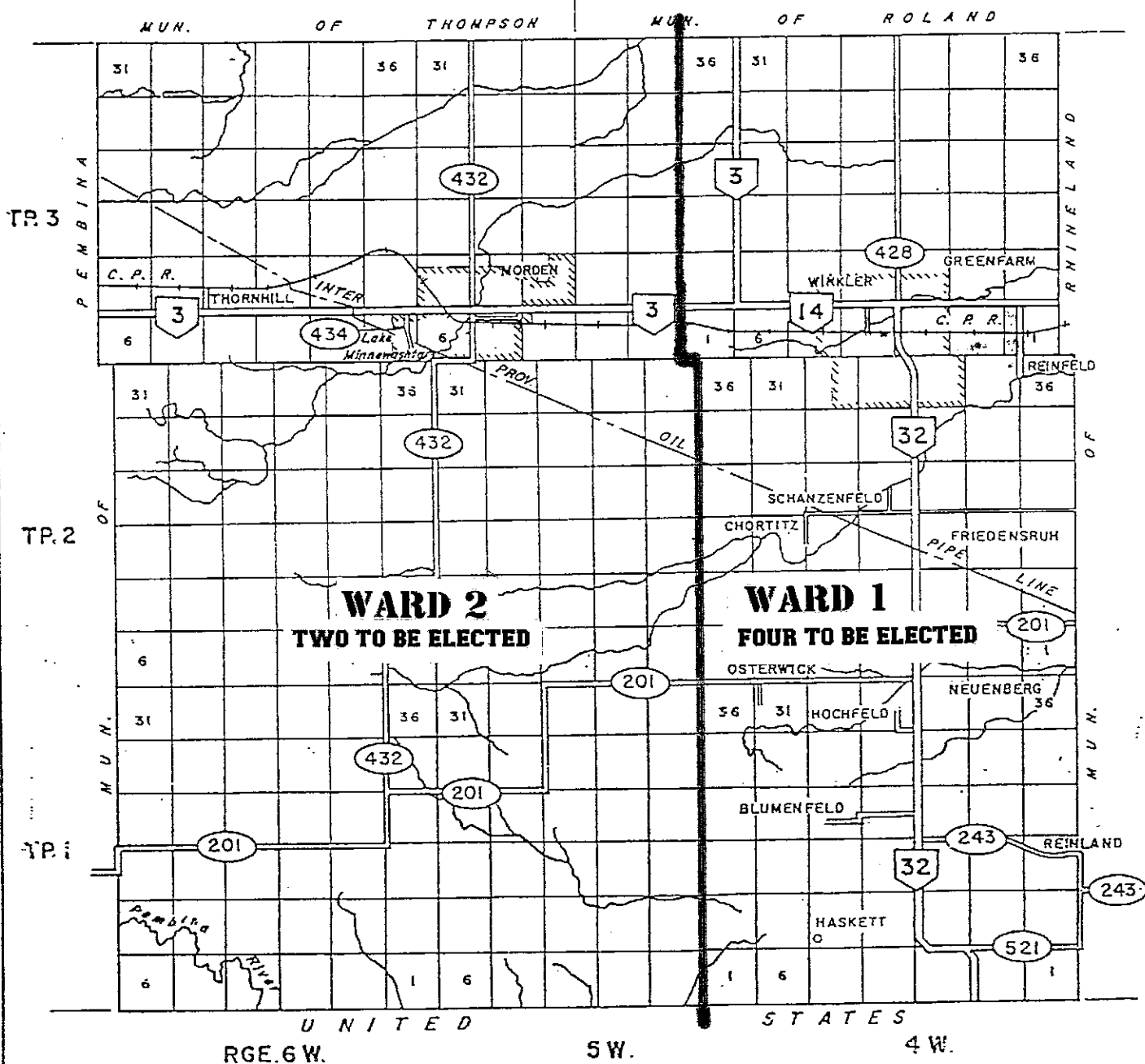



