STANLEY CENTENNIAL PARK SHELTERS

Welcome to the Stanley Centennial Park! Please help us to maintain the park as a safe and pristine place to visit for now and for future generations. We hope you enjoy your stay at the park!

Please follow current Manitoba Health Guidelines.

Park Amenities:

- Primitive Camping
- Reserved Shelters
- Restroom Facilities
- Disc Golf
- Baseball Diamonds
- Soccer Pitch
- Shelter #3 in the RV camping area is available for those with a reserved site on a first come basis.

Shelter Booking Information:

- Please set up within the specific shelter reserved, respect other users of the park.
- All park areas are open to the public and available on a first come basis.
- All vehicles must be parked in a designated parking lot, even after transportation of supplies and physically disabled persons to shelter areas. Drive with extreme caution through the park.
- Well water (including at restrooms) – not treated for human consumption.
- You are required to bring your own firewood. Please be respectful of any fire bans as signed.
- Any electrical plugs at the shelters are for small appliances only.
- Permission for all temporary structures larger than 10' x 10' is required. A permit must be obtained and location to be arranged with Park Attendant prior to arrival.
- Parking attendants may be required for larger groups.
- The coordinator of the event is responsible for the conduct of the group they represent.
- Maximum attendance of 150 people per shelter reservation.
- Please clean the shelter before leaving - sweep floors, wipe counters, carry out garbage.

Rules of the Park:

- 1) Check-In Time: 7:00am Check-Out Time: 11:00pm
- 2) One picnic table, one fire pit per site. Please do not relocate without permission.
- 3) Pets must be leashed, under physical control at all times, and be cleaned up after.
- 4) Please use recycling and garbage bins as provided.
- 5) Do your part to keep restrooms clean.
- 6) Alcohol consumption is not allowed within the park limits.
- 7) Nuisance noise is not acceptable.
- 8) No ATVs, UTVs, tractors, or other off-road equipment allowed in the park.
