STANLEY CENTENNIAL PARK CAMPING

Park Amenities:

- Baseball Diamonds
- Soccer Pitch
- Shelter #3 in the RV camping area is available for those with a reserved site on a first come basis.

Campers should be aware of the following:

All sites are unserviced – no sewer, water, or electrical connections.

- Please set up within the specific site reserved. All other park areas are open to the public.
- One vehicle is allowed per camp site. All other vehicles must be parked in a designated parking lot. Drive with extreme caution through the park.
- One extra tent may be set up per site as space allows.
- Well water (including at restrooms) – not treated for human consumption.
- You are required to bring your own firewood. Please be respectful of any fire bans as signed.

Rules of the Park:

- 1) Check-In Time: 12:00 Noon
- 2) Check-Out Time: 11:00am
- 3) One picnic table, one fire pit per site. Please do not relocate without permission.
- 4) Pets must be leashed, under physical control at all times, and be cleaned up after.
- 5) Please use recycling and garbage bins as provided.
- 6) Do your part to keep restrooms clean.
- 7) Alcohol consumption is not allowed within the park limits.
- 8) Nuisance noise is not acceptable.
- 9) No ATVs, UTV, or other off -road equipment is to be used in the park.
